Ask questions about the story: who are the characters, what is the setting, how can you retell the story and sequence the events? Comprehension is as important as fluency. We are working on writing 3 sentence stories using inventive spelling and our word wall words. Students will need to strive hard to increase their sight words so they can move up on our Karate sight words towards Black Belt (80).

At this point, it is important that your child can name and write all capital and lowercase letters and numbers 0-20 correctly. Don't forget to practice independently counting to 100. April weather can bring many changes, so please be mindful of dressing your child appropriately and work on shoe tying. As always, we appreciate your help at home. **Kindergarten**
